The Artemis I mission, which successfully and spectacularly launched in the early morning hours of Nov. 16, 2022, is being managed by JSC's Mission Control Center. Wyche said NASA is making partnerships with everyone who wants to be part of Artemis.

According to Wyche, research, innovation, and workforce development are vital to maintain NASA JSC as the home of human spaceflight.
